A	<p>Important Dates.</p> <p>Saturday, 1st June 2023. Team nominations are open.</p> <p>Friday, 20th October 2023. Team nominations will close.</p> <p>Wednesday, 1st November 2023. Round 1.</p> <p>Wednesday, 13th December 2023. Round 7 will be the last round for 2023.</p> <p>Wednesday, 31st January 2024. Round 8 will be the first round for 2024.</p> <p>Wednesday, 14th February 2024. General Bye - Junior State Cup Southern.</p> <p>Wednesday, 20th March 2023. Grand Final.</p>
B	<p>Mixed Competition</p> <p>As per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 4.1.2.</p> <p><u>Wednesday Night</u> Mixed Open Competition. This competition is a mixed competition with teams nominating in either a 6pm or 7pm timeslot to play in. Teams can nominate and play in 1 of 4 classifications - Open Age Family Team, Open Age Friends and Work Team, Under 20's and Over 30's.</p> <p>Twelve (12) round competition with a two (2) week finals series.</p>
C	<p>Player Eligibility.</p> <p>All conditions of player eligibility will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.</p> <p>WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.7. Players must be born no earlier than 2003 and must be no later than 2010. (13 years to 20 years of age). (For competitions commencing 2023).</p> <p>WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.8. Players must be born in 2010 or before. (13 years or older). (For competitions commencing 2023).</p> <p>WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.9. Players must be born in 1993 or before. (30 years or older). (For competitions commencing 2023).</p>
D	<p>Team Registration</p> <p>All conditions of entry will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.</p> <p>The link to register your team into your chosen competition can be found HERE.</p> <p>A requirement for WTA to accept a Teams nomination in the Youth League, Junior competitions and Mixed competitions. Team Coordinator/Team Manager must click HERE and fill out the relevant information following entering your team on MySideline as stated in Section 6.1.1.</p> <p>Team Coordinators/Team Managers are reminded to have a minimum of ten (10) players registered as per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.1.3.</p>

F	<p>Player Registration and Registration Fee.</p>
	<p>All conditions of player registration will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 7.</p> <p>To register as a player, hopefully, your Team Coordinator/Team Manager has emailed a team invitation. If not can register by clicking HERE. You will need to know your Team name.</p> <p>REGISTRATION FEE FOR ALL OF THIS SEASONS MIXED COMPETITION:- \$105.00 inc GST</p> <p>Please Note: As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 7.2. When you enter MySideline to register for your first competition, you will be prompted to pay a national membership fee of \$22.00. Once you have paid your annual membership, you can register for as many competitions as you like in that year. A year commences 1 July through to 30 June.</p> <p>Just a reminder to players, there is a late fee for players from when team nominations close till Round Five (5), including 100% of the registration fee plus a \$20.00 late registration fee.</p>
E	<p>Duty Referee.</p>
	<p>As per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 8.5.</p> <p>The team nominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed one (1) game per rostered duty team. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game).</p> <p>Duty teams will be paid \$30 per game and will be paid at the end of the season</p> <p>Failure to supply a duty referee will result in a \$40 fine and the following: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty will lose four (4) competition points. 2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty will lose two (2) competition points. <p>Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.</p> <p>Duty Referees will be paid at the end of the season and will need to provide banking details.</p>
