A	<p>Important Dates.</p> <p>Saturday, 1st July 2024. Team nominations are open.</p> <p>Friday, 25th October 2024. Team nominations will close.</p> <p>Wednesday, 6th November 2024. Round 1.</p> <p>Wednesday, 18th December 2024. Round 7 will be the last round for 2024.</p> <p>Wednesday, 5th February 2025. Round 8 will be the first round for 2025.</p> <p>Wednesday, 12th February 2025. General Bye - Junior State Cup Southern.</p> <p>Wednesday, 26th March 2025. Grand Final.</p>
B	<p>Mixed Competition</p> <p>As per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 4.1.2.</p> <p><u>Wednesday Night</u> Mixed Open Competition. This competition is a mixed competition. With teams nominating in either a 6 pm or 7 pm timeslot to play in. Teams can nominate and play in 1 of 4 classifications - Open Age Family Team, Open Age Friends and Work Team, Under 20's and Over 30's</p> <p>Twelve (12) competition rounds with a two (2) week finals series.</p>
C	<p>Player Eligibility.</p> <p>All conditions of player eligibility will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.</p> <p>20'S MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.6.1. Players must be born no earlier than 2004 and must be no later than 2011. (13 years to 20 years of age). (For competitions commencing 2024).</p> <p>OPEN'S MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.3.1. Players must be born in 2011 or before (13 years or older). (For competitions commencing 2024).</p> <p>30'S MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.8.1. Players must be born in 1994 or before. (30 years or older). (For competitions commencing 2024).</p>
D	<p>Team Registration</p> <p>All conditions of entry will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.</p> <p>The link to register your team into your chosen competition can be found HERE.</p> <p>A requirement for WTA is to accept a team nomination in the junior or MIXED competition. The team coordinator/team manager will need to click HERE and fill out the relevant information after entering your team on MySideline, as stated in Section 6.1.1.</p> <p>The team coordinator/manager is reminded to have a minimum of ten (10) players registered as per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.1.3.</p>

F	<p>Player Registration and Registration Fee.</p> <p>All player registration conditions must be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 7.</p> <p>Your team coordinator/manager has emailed a team invitation for you to register as a player. If not, you can register by clicking HERE. You will need to know your team name.</p> <p>REGISTRATION FEE FOR THIS SEASONS MIXED COMPETITION: - \$110.00 inc GST.</p> <p>Please Note: As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 7.2. When you enter MySideline to register for your first competition, you will be prompted to pay a national membership fee of \$22.00. Once you have paid your annual membership, you can register for as many competitions as you would like that year. A year commences 1 July through to 30 June.</p> <p>This is just a reminder for players that there is a late fee from when team nominations close until Round Five (5), including 100% of the registration fee plus a \$20.00 late registration fee.</p>
E	<p>Duty Referee.</p> <p>All teams are required to provide a duty referee when rostered. The team-nominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed one (1) game per rostered duty team. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game).</p> <p>Duty teams will be paid \$30 per game and will be paid at the end of the season.</p> <p>Failure to supply a duty referee will result in a \$50 fine and the following: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose four (4) competition points. 2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose two (2) competition points. <p>Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.</p>
