A	<p>Important Dates.</p> <p>Saturday, 4th January 2025. Team nominations are open.</p> <p>Friday, 31st January 2025. Team nominations will close.</p> <p>Tuesday, 4th February 2025. Round 1.</p> <p>Tuesday, 11th February 2025. General bye. (NSW JSC)</p> <p>Tuesday, 15th April 2025. Grand Final.</p>
B	<p>Men's and Women's Open Competition.</p> <p>As per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 4.1.2</p> <p><u>Tuesday Night</u> Men's and Women's Open Competition. (Includes previously known youth league competition) This is an open competition for men and women. It is ideal for social players. Pending team nominations, the men may have three (3) graded pools and the women two (2) graded pools or more if required.</p> <p>Eleven (8) round competition with a three (2) week finals series.</p>
C	<p>Player Eligibility.</p> <p>All conditions of player eligibility will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.</p> <p>WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.3.1. Players must be born in 2012 or before (13 years or older). (For competitions commencing 2025).</p>
D	<p>Team Registration.</p> <p>All conditions of entry will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.</p> <p>The link to register your team into your chosen competition can be found HERE.</p> <p>The team coordinator/manager is reminded to have a minimum of ten (10) players registered as per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.1.3.</p>
E	<p>Player Registration and Registration Fee.</p> <p>All player registration conditions must be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 7.</p> <p>Your team coordinator/manager has emailed a team invitation for you to register as a player. If not, you can register by clicking HERE. You will need to know your team name.</p> <p>REGISTRATION FEE FOR THIS SEASONS MEN'S AND WOMEN'S OPEN COMPETITION: - \$100.00 inc GST.</p> <p>Please Note: As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 7.2. When you enter MySideline to register for your first competition, you will be prompted to pay a national membership fee of \$22.00. Once you have paid your annual membership, you can register for as many competitions as you would like that year. A year commences 1 July through to 30 June.</p> <p>This is just a reminder for players that there is a late fee from when team nominations close until Round Five (5), including 100% of the registration fee plus a \$20.00 late registration fee.</p>

F	<p>Duty Referee.</p>
	<p>Men's Open teams are required to provide a Duty Referee when rostered. Pending the nomination of teams, the Women's Open Teams will be asked to supply a duty referee next. The team-nominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed one (1) game per rostered duty team. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game).</p> <p>Duty teams will be paid \$30 per game and will be paid at the end of the season.</p> <p>Failure to supply a duty referee will result in the following: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose four (4) competition points. 2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose two (2) competition points. <p>Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.</p>
