	Tuesday Night Men's and Women's Open Competition. (Includes previously known youth league competition) This is an open competition for men and women. It is ideal for social players. Pending team nominations, the men may have three (3) graded pools and the women two (2) graded pools or more if required. Twelve (12) round competition with a three (3) week finals series. Women's 30 and Over Competition This is a social competition for women 30 years and over. It has modified rules – seven (7) a side, with the acting half not allowed to run. If four (4) teams are not nominated in this competition, these teams will be moved into the lowest grade of women's open, but not in the competition that was formerly known as girls' youth league.		
C Player Eligibility. All conditions of player eligibility will need to be followed as per the WTA General Condi Section 5.			e WTA General Conditions of Entry,

D	Team Registration.		
	All conditions of entry must be followed as outlined in the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 6. The link to register your team in your chosen competition can be found HERE. The team coordinator/manager is reminded to have a minimum of ten (10) players registered as per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.1.3.		
E	All player registration conditions must be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 7. Your team coordinator/manager has emailed a team invitation for you to register as a player. If not, you can register by clicking HERE. You will need to know your team's name. COMPETITION FEE FOR THIS SEASON'S: - \$60.00 inc GST. Please Note: As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Sections 7.2, 7.3 and 7.4. 7.2.1 WTA annual membership fee of \$2.00. This membership fee is in accordance with the Constitution of the Wagga Wagga Touch Association Incorporated, Part 2 – Membership, clause 9.1: Fees and Subscriptions.

Once you have paid your annual membership fees, you can register in as many competitions as you would like the membership expires on 30 June each year.

F Duty Referee.

Men's Open teams are required to nominate and provide a Duty Referee when rostered. Pending the nomination of teams, the Women's Open Teams will be asked to supply a duty referee next. The teamnominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed for one (1) game per rostered duty team. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game).

Duty referees will be paid \$30 per game and will receive payment on the night of the game they referee.

Failure to supply a duty referee will result in the following: -

- 1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose four (4) competition points.
- 2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose two (2) competition points.

Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.
