B	Men's and Women's Premier League.
	<p>As per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 4.1.2.</p> <p><u>Tuesday Night</u> Men's and Women's Premier League. This is an open men's and women's competition for our elite players. This is WTA's showcase competition.</p> <p>Nine (9) round competition with a three (3) week finals series.</p>
C	Player Eligibility.
	<p>All conditions of player eligibility will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 5.</p> <p>WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.4.1. Players must be born in 2012 or before (13 years or older) (For competitions commencing 2025)</p>
D	Team Registration.
	<p>All conditions of entry will need to be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 6.</p> <p>The link to register your team into your chosen competition can be found HERE.</p> <p>The team coordinator/manager is reminded to have a minimum of ten (10) players registered as per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.1.3.</p>
F	Player Registration, Membership and Competition Fees.
	<p>All player registration conditions must be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 7.</p> <p>Your team coordinator/manager has emailed a team invitation for you to register as a player. If not, you can register by clicking HERE. You will need to know your team's name.</p> <p>COMPETITION FEE FOR THIS SEASON: - \$75.00 inc GST.</p> <p>Please Note: As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Sections 7.2, 7.3 and 7.4.</p> <p>7.2.1. - WTA annual membership fee of \$2.00. This membership fee is in accordance with the <i>Constitution of the Wagga Wagga Touch Association Incorporated</i>, Part 2 – Membership, clause 9.1: Fees and Subscriptions.</p> <p>7.3.1. - TFA National membership fee of \$22.00. NSWTA state membership fee of \$30.00.</p> <p>7.4.1. - Wagga Wagga City Council ground fee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$41.00 for senior players • \$33.00 for junior players <p><i>Once you have paid your annual membership fees, you can register in as many competitions as you would like the membership expires on 30 June each year.</i></p>

G	Duty Referee.
	<p>All teams are required to nominate and provide a duty referee when rostered. The team-nominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed for one (1) game per rostered duty team. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game).</p> <p>Duty referees will be paid \$30 per game and will receive payment on the night of the game they referee.</p> <p>Failure to supply a duty referee will result in a \$50 fine and the following: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose four (4) competition points. 2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose two (2) competition points. <p>Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.</p>
H	Draw Matches.
	<p>All matches will need a result. If a match is drawn at full time, a drop-off will be played to decide the winner.</p> <p>Touch Football Australia 8th Edition rule book. Rule 24 Drop off.</p>
