	OPEN MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.3.1. Players must be born in 2012 or before (13 years or older). (For competitions commencing in 2025).			
	30'S MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.8.1. Players must be born in 1995 or before. (30 years or older). (For competitions commencing in 2025).			

### F Team Registration

All conditions of entry must be adhered to as outlined in Section 6 of the WTA General Conditions of Entry.

To register your team for your selected competition, please use the link provided [HERE].

A requirement for WTA is to accept a team nomination in the **junior** or **MIXED** competition. The team coordinator/team manager will need to click **HERE** and fill out the relevant information after entering your team on MySideline, as stated in Section 6.1.1.

Additionally, email a copy of your duty referee's qualification certificate to tournaments@waggatouch.com.au.

The team coordinator/manager is reminded to have a minimum of ten (10) players registered as per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.1.3.

# G Player Registration, Membership and Competition Fees.

All player registration conditions must be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 7.

Your team coordinator/manager has emailed a team invitation for you to register as a player. If not, you can register by clicking <u>HERE</u>. You will need to know your team's name.

### **Please Note:**

As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Sections 7.2, 7.3 and 7.4.

- 7.2.1. WTA annual membership fee of **\$2.00**. This membership fee is in accordance with the *Constitution of the Wagga Wagga Touch Association Incorporated*, Part 2 Membership, clause 9.1: Fees and Subscriptions.
- 7.3.1. TFA National membership fee of \$30.00. NSWTA state membership fee of \$30.00.
- 7.4.1. Wagga Wagga City Council ground fee.
  - \$41.00 for senior players
  - \$33.00 for junior players

Once you have paid your annual membership fees, you can register in as many competitions as you would like the membership expires on 30 June each year.

# H Duty Referee General Information

The Duty Referee must hold an Affiliate Level (formerly the Level 1) or higher refereeing accreditation. Courses will be run during or before each competition for all interested people.

Additionally, email a copy of your duty referee's qualification certificate to tournaments@waggatouch.com.au.

Teams that do not nominate an accredited Duty Referee when registering a team will not be accepted into the competition.

Any changes to a team's Duty Referee should be notified to WTA as soon as possible. Also, if your duty referee is unable to attend when rostered, it is the team's responsibility to find a replacement.

It is the Duty Referee's responsibility to sign the duty referee sheet.

Duty Referees are required to report to the Club Rooms 10 minutes before the start of the game.

Duty Referees are required to provide their own whistle and wear the provided fluoro vest or their provided McDonald's Referee Shirt. All referees are required to wear closed shoes.

The minimum age for a referee at a senior competition and the mixed competition is fourteen (14) years old.

Any request for dispensation outside this clause needs to be in writing and endorsed by WTA.

Duty Referee.

All teams are required to provide a duty referee when rostered. The team-nominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed for one (1) game per rostered duty team. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game).

Duty teams will be paid \$30 per game and will receive their payment at the end of the season.

Failure to supply a duty referee will result in a \$50 fine and the following: 
1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose four (4) competition points.

2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose two (2) competition points.

Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.
