	<p><b>Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026.</b> Team nominations are open.</p> <p><b>Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2026.</b> Round 1.</p> <p><b>Monday, 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026.</b> Grand Final.</p> <p><b>Friday, 30<sup>th</sup> January 2026.</b> Team nominations will close.</p> <p><b>Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> April 2026.</b> General Bye. (Easter Monday)</p>
B	<h2>Men's 35 Competition Pools and Categories.</h2>
	<p>As per WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 4.1.2.</p> <p><b>Monday Night</b> <b>Men's 35 and Over Competition – Season 1 and 2 Competition</b> This is a social competition for men aged 35 and older. It has modified rules – seven (7) a side, with the acting half not allowed to run. There will be three (3) pools within this competition.</p> <p>Twelve (12) round competition with a three (3) week finals series.</p>
C	<h2>Player Eligibility.</h2>
	<p>All conditions of player eligibility must be followed as outlined in the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 5.</p> <p>WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.1.1. Players must be born in 1991 or before. (35 years or older). (For competitions commencing that year in Season 1).</p>
D	<h2>Team Registration.</h2>
	<p>All conditions of entry must be followed as outlined in the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 6.</p> <p>The link to register your team in your chosen competition can be found <a href="#">HERE</a>.</p> <p>The team coordinator/manager is reminded to have a minimum of ten (10) players registered as per <b>WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 6.1.3</b>.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>JUST A REMINDER, TEAMS CAN ONLY REGISTER A MAXIMUM OF 14 PLAYERS PER TEAM.</b></p>
E	<h2>Player Registration, Membership and Competition Fees.</h2>
	<p>All player registration conditions must be followed as per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 7.</p> <p>Your team coordinator/manager can email you a team invitation to register as a player. If not, you can register by clicking <a href="#">HERE</a>. You will need to know your team's name.</p> <p><b>COMPETITION FEE FOR THIS SEASON: - \$75.00 inc GST.</b></p> <p><i>Just a reminder: players registering and paying the competition fee after the team nominations closure date will incur a \$20 late fee. As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 9.1.4.</i></p> <p><b>Please Note:</b> As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Sections 7.2, 7.3 and 7.4.</p> <p>7.2.1. - WTA annual membership fee of <b>\$2.00</b>. This membership fee is in accordance with the <i>Constitution of the Wagga Wagga Touch Association Incorporated</i>, Part 2 – Membership, clause 9.1: Fees and Subscriptions.</p> <p>7.3.1. - TFA National membership fee of <b>\$30.00</b>. NSWTA state membership fee of <b>\$30.00</b>.</p>

	<p>7.4.1. - Wagga Wagga City Council ground fee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>\$41.00</b> for senior players</li> <li>• <b>\$33.00</b> for junior players</li> </ul> <p><i>Once you have paid your annual membership fees, you can register in as many competitions as you would like. The membership expires on 30 June each year.</i></p>
F	<p><b>Duty Referee.</b></p>
	<p>All teams are required to nominate and provide a duty referee when rostered. The team-nominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed for one (1) game per rostered duty team. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game).</p> <p>Duty referees will be paid \$30 per game and will receive payment on the night of the game.</p> <p>Failure to supply a duty referee will result in the following: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose four (4) competition points.</li> <li>2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose two (2) competition points.</li> </ol> <p>Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.</p>
