	<p>A compulsory meeting for all Mixed Competition teams will be held at the Jubilee Park Clubroom on Wednesday, 30th September 2026.</p> <p>Attendance is mandatory - a representative from each team must attend this meeting in order for the team to be included in the competition draw. Only teams that attend the meeting will receive the team nomination invitation.</p> <p>Meeting Schedule:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teams nominating for the 6:00 PM timeslot must attend the 6:00 PM session. • Teams nominating for the 7:00 PM timeslot must attend the 7:00 PM session. <p>Each meeting is expected to run for no longer than 30 minutes.</p>									

<p>E</p>	<p>Player Eligibility.</p> <p>All conditions of player eligibility must be complied with in accordance with Section 5 of the WTA General Conditions of Entry.</p> <p>20'S MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.6.1. Players must be born between 2006 and 2013. (13 years to 20 years of age). (For competitions commencing that year in Season 2).</p> <p>OPEN MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.7.1. Players must be born in 2013 or before. (13 years or older). (For competitions commencing that year in Season 2).</p> <p>30'S MIXED COMPETITION WTA General Conditions of Entry Section 5.2.8.1. Players must be born in 1996 or before. (30 years or older). (For competitions commencing that year in Season 2).</p>
<p>F</p>	<p>Team Registration</p> <p>All Conditions of Entry must be complied with in accordance with Section 6 of the WTA General Conditions of Entry.</p> <p>Only teams that attend the meeting will receive the team nomination invitation.</p> <p>To nominate your team for your selected competition, please complete the Team Nomination Form by clicking HERE.</p> <p>Once your team nomination has been submitted, please click HERE. to nominate your team's Duty Referee, as required under Section 8 of the WTA General Conditions of Entry. Failure to nominate a Duty Referee by the team nomination closing date may result in your team being ineligible to participate in the competition until this requirement has been met.</p> <p>Please also confirm with your nominated Duty Referee that a copy of their current referee accreditation certificate has been provided to the WTA Tournament Director. If it has not, please email a copy of the accreditation certificate to tournaments@waggatouch.com.au.</p> <p>Team Coordinators/Managers are reminded that a minimum of ten (10) registered players is required by the team nomination closing date, in accordance with Section 6.1.3 of the WTA General Conditions of Entry.</p> <p>Please note that teams may register a maximum of fourteen (14) players per team.</p>
<p>G</p>	<p>Player Registration, Membership and Competition Fees.</p> <p>All player registration conditions must be complied with in accordance with Section 7 of the WTA General Conditions of Entry.</p> <p>Your team coordinator/manager can email you a team invitation to register as a player. If not, you can register by clicking HERE. You will need to know your team's name.</p> <p>COMPETITION FEE FOR THIS SEASON: - \$60.00 inc GST.</p> <p>Just a reminder: <i>players registering and paying the competition fee after the team nominations closure date will incur a \$20 late fee. As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Section 9.1.4.</i></p> <p>Please Note: As per the WTA General Conditions of Entry, Sections 7.2, 7.3 and 7.4.</p> <p>7.2.1. - WTA annual membership fee of \$2.00. This membership fee is in accordance with the <i>Constitution of the Wagga Wagga Touch Association Incorporated</i>, Part 2 – Membership, clause 9.1: Fees and Subscriptions.</p>

H	Duty Referee General Information
	<p>Each team must nominate one (1) Duty Referee who holds a current Affiliate Referee Accreditation (formerly Level 1) or higher. WTA will conduct referee accreditation courses before and during each competition for those wishing to become accredited.</p> <p>Teams that fail to nominate an accredited Duty Referee by the team nomination closing date may not be accepted into the competition.</p> <p>Once your team nomination has been submitted, the Team Coordinator/Manager must complete the Duty Referee Nomination Form by clicking HERE..</p> <p>The Team Coordinator/Manager must also ensure that a copy of the nominated Duty Referee's current referee accreditation certificate has been provided to the WTA Tournament Director. If WTA has not previously received a copy, it must be emailed to tournaments@waggatouch.com.au.</p> <p>If a team's nominated Duty Referee changes at any time during the season, the Team Coordinator/Manager must notify WTA as soon as practicable. If the nominated Duty Referee is unavailable for a scheduled duty, it is the team's responsibility to arrange a suitably accredited replacement.</p> <p>The minimum age for a Duty Referee officiating in a Senior Competition or the Mixed Competition is fourteen (14) years of age.</p> <p>The minimum age for a Duty Referee officiating in a Junior Competition is twelve (12) years of age.</p> <p>Any request for dispensation from this requirement must be submitted to WTA in writing and approved by WTA prior to the referee officiating.</p> <p>On their allocated duty, the Duty Referee must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • report to the Club Rooms at least ten (10) minutes before the scheduled commencement of the game; • sign the Duty Referee Sign-on Sheet before officiating; • provide their own whistle; • wear the WTA-provided fluorescent referee vest, the TFA Official Referee Uniform, or the approved McDonald's Referee Shirt; and • wear fully enclosed footwear at all times while officiating.
I	Duty Referee.
	<p>All teams are required to nominate and provide a duty referee. Your duty referee will be required when your team is the HOME TEAM on the draw. The team-nominated duty referee or duty referees will be appointed to referee that rounds match. (WTA suggest a team should have two (2) duty referees attend to share the game and also to have a backup option).</p> <p>Duty rostered teams will be paid \$30 per game and will receive their payment at the end of the season.</p> <p>Failure to supply a duty referee will result in a \$50 fine and the following: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the team wins that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose four (4) competition points. 2. If the team loses that match when rostered on for duty, they will lose two (2) competition points. <p>Teams that fail to supply a duty referee may also face further action as determined by the WTA Board.</p>
